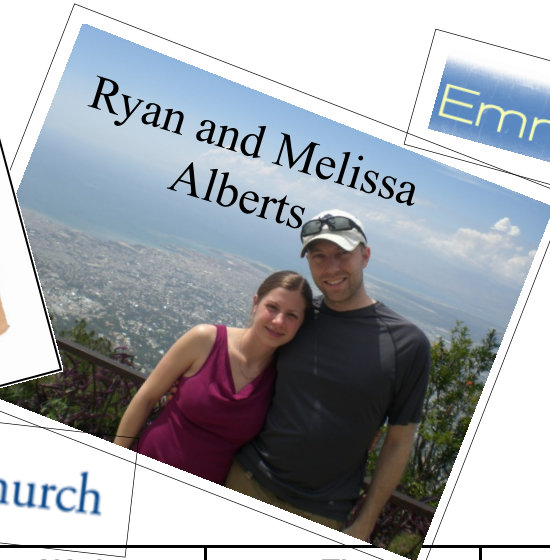
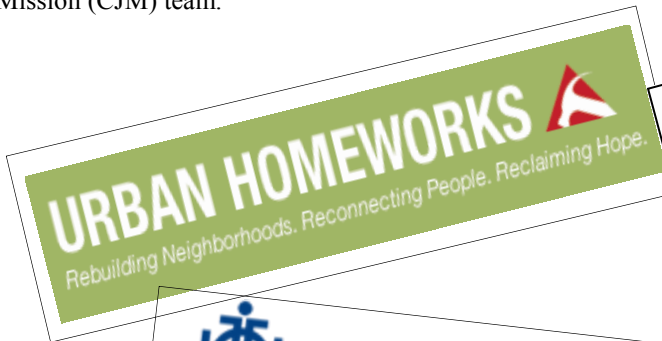


We ask that for the month of November you partner with our ECC partners in prayer. Please lift up these ministries and people in specific ways listed below on each day.
