Expectations

If we're going to max out the potential of this event, we've got to work together. Therefore, we expect high levels of maturity from all participants. The following expectations are in effect from the time you are dropped off until the time you are picked up. Consequences for violations include loss of privileges, a call to your parents, ineligibility for future events, or even a trip home at your expense.

1. Deposits may be non-refundable

If the ECC Tween Leadership Team determines that your son/daughter isn't quite ready for this event prior to the application deadline, your deposit will be refunded in full. Because every registration directly impacts the overall cost of this event, it is unlikely that we will be able to refund your deposit after our registration deadline.

2. Plan to attend the event from start to finish.

Retreats provide a unique opportunity to detox from everyday life as we immerse ourselves in uninterrupted Christian community. If people are coming and going, it works against our goal of providing a true "retreat" experience for the rest of the group.

3. Be where you are supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.

4. Respect people and property.

We want you to have fun, but not at someone's expense. Uncooperative, unkind, or destructive behavior towards people or property will not be tolerated. Damage will be paid by those responsible.

5. The Pink and Blue rule is in effect.

6. The following items are not allowed:

- Personal electronic devices – including cell phones
- Books, magazines, and other reading material that isn't distinctly Christian
- Fireworks, electronic pointing devices, or weapons (including knives)
- Drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, or anything illegal
