

A retreat at Adventurous Christians includes access to the camp's equipment that is used to explore the surrounding Superior National Forest and Boundary Waters. This includes all cross-country ski equipment and snowshoes for winter retreats. To enhance your wilderness retreat, you will be served delicious made from scratch meals and will stay in rustic, yet comfortable, warm and clean cabins. Only the lodge has running water and there are only outdoor lavatories. However, the outhouses are lovely log structures with private stalls, which are clean and well kept. We will clean up on Saturday evening in the traditional sauna fashion, with a dip in frozen Bow Lake for the adventurous of heart! The lodge is where most of the activity occurs at camp. Constructed in a vintage post and beam architecture, the lodge has pleasant woodsy appeal and offers spectacular views on all sides of the beautiful forested area. It also boasts a huge stone fireplace that can also be used as a climbing wall. The dining hall is also in the lodge, and provides continuous access to organic coffees, teas, hot chocolate and homemade goodies.
